Do you love fishing and canoeing? Join us for a "free fishing" canoe float along the Sandusky State Scenic River. Guided by staff from the Ohio Division of Wildlife, this trip will give you a chance to learn more about habitat and fish ecology while improving your chance to catch white bass, catfish, and sunfish. All equipment will be provided and as a free fishing day, no license is needed either.

Previous paddling and fishing experience is recommended for this 2.5-mile float. All participants must be 16 or older and are required to wear a personal flotation device. Limited spots available so registration in advance is required. (Walk-ins will not be accepted.) Indian Mill Scenic River Access Upper Sandusky.
